- Restaurants are to close at 9 p.m.
- Do not gather and drink alcohol in the streets or in parks

Venues for gatherings (Wedding venues)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Businesses that provide Karaoke</li> </ul> <p>Restaurants and cafes: Do not provide Karaoke</p> <p>Businesses other than restaurants and cafes: Do not allow many people to gather in one room.</p> <p>Keep your premises well ventilated at all times.</p> <p>Take care to prevent the spread of Covid-19.</p>
