- **5** Others














A Letter and a Vaccine Ticket Arrived from the Government Office - What do I do Next?



1. Make a Vaccination Reservation.

Reservations can be made over the phone or internet.







2. Get your Vaccination Where You Reserved it.

Vaccines are administered to the upper arms, so please wear clothing that will easily allow for this.

Please bring the following when you get vaccinated:

- Your vaccine ticket
- Personal identification (such as a residence card or passport)

3. You will get two vaccination shots.
