

A Request to the Residents of Tokyo with Regards to COVID-19

- The situation will become dangerous if the number of Covid-19 cases starts to increase again.
- Basic measures are continually implemented in Tokyo.
It is important to prevent Covid-19 cases from increasing.
- This is a request for people to change their everyday lives in order to prevent the spread of Covid-19.

Period

From midnight December 1st (Wednesday)

Request

People living in Tokyo

- Avoid places that do not have windows or are poorly ventilated.
- Avoid going out at peak hours or to crowded areas.
- Do not be close to other people when you talk, and do not speak in a loud voice.
- Keep your distance from other people.
- Wear a mask.
- Wash your hands many times per day.
- Be extra careful when coming and going to and from Tokyo for work or travel.
Especially, please avoid entering or leaving Tokyo, especially when feverish.
- Do not gather and drink alcohol in the streets or in parks



Venues for gatherings (Wedding venues)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Businesses that have not obtained an 'Infection Prevention Inspection Certificate'* or do not display the certificate outside their business may: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Have groups of up to four seated at the same table. · Serve alcohol from 11 am to 9 pm. · Allow customers to bring their own alcohol from 11am to 9 pm.

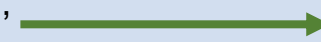
■ Establishments where people do not speak loudly

* 'Capacity' means the number of people that can fit in an establishment

- 5,000 or less capacity: Full capacity OK
- 5,000 to 10,000 capacity: No more than 5,000
- 10,000 or more capacity: 50% capacity

— When submitting 'Infection Prevention Safe Plans' to the Tokyo Metropolitan Government, full capacity is allowable in venues with 5,000 or more people and 50% or more of capacity.

- Run at 50% capacity
